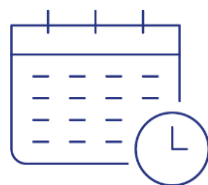
### OUR PROJECT

As the world's largest tourist destination, Mediterranean ports are under intense tourist pressure. This makes them highly vulnerable to overtourism.

ECO-SEAROUTES aims to create eco-nautical routes connecting ports committed to a common sustainability standard in a transnational approach, and to redistribute tourism flows to neighbouring coastal and inland areas. Through a bottom-up and participatory approach, the project activates local decision-makers and tourism actors to valorise peripheral areas and their cultural heritage.
